


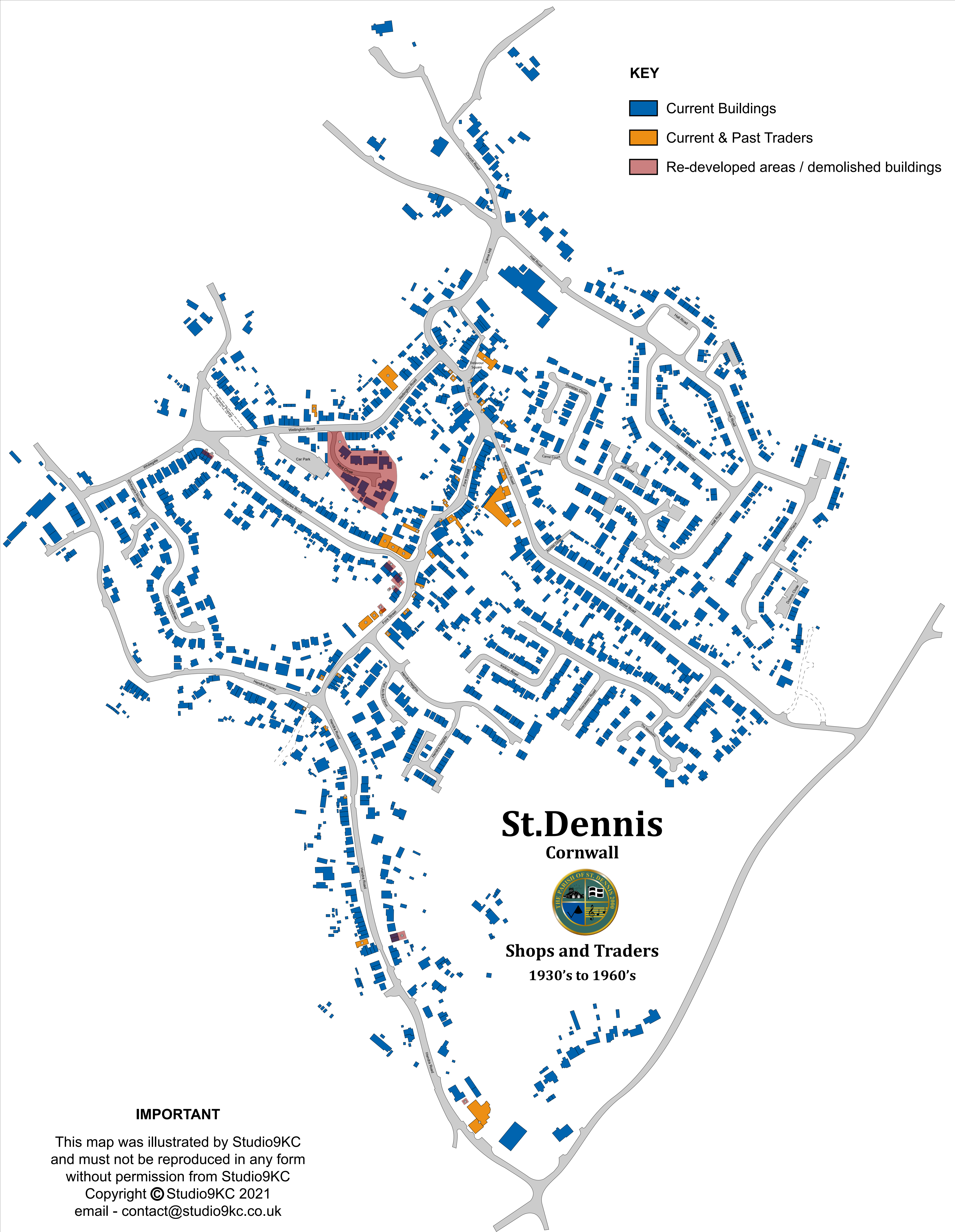

48. shoe repair shop run by Mr. Kessell.

52. Bullen's carpenter shop. This has now closed.
